- 20-foot setback from Spring Trail as guide





### Applicable Standards

SOI Standard 9 was previously not met:

New additions, exterior alterations, or related new construction shall not destroy historic materials that characterize the property. The new work shall be differentiated from the old and shall be compatible with the massing, size, scale, and architectural features to protect the historic integrity of the property and its environment.



# Staff Recommendation

Staff believes that the standards for granting a Certificate of Appropriateness are met and recommends the Landmarks Commission approve the project with the following condition:

1. Submit archaeological monitoring report at conclusion of grounddisturbing activities.
