### Street Tree Report – Land Use Application

In exercising its responsibility under the foregoing ordinances and Department Of Public Works construction specifications, the Forestry Section requires the applicant to submit a Street Tree Report from a certified arborist as part of a <u>Land Use Application</u> submittal. The Forestry Section will evaluate the report below for street tree protection during construction activities, proposed tree removals and deposits for developers' agreements as part of the forestry approval process. If it is necessary to remove a street tree, a separate permit from Forestry will be required. The Forestry Section must be informed of any change in this information as it could impact the Forestry Section's report and approval.

Please note on the **proposed plan** any pruning beyond what is considered to be acceptable by **ANSI A300 pruning standards** or if street tree removal may be necessary due to the impacts of construction, staging/delivery are as, or other activities.

#### Additional notes:

The ash tree (number 1 on the list) could possibly be removed and replaced when construction in completes. This tree does have some visible deadwood and some suckering that could indiate stress. The health of this tree does have potential for decline due to the current condition.

#### Describe impacts and any mitigation actions employed:

For the 2 elms and 1 ash that are to be kept: construction equipment traffic and material staging should not come within 8ft of the trees on the grass sides and should not be closer than the sidewalk or road on the those sides. I recommed some kind of fencing of physical barrier to enforce this. This will minimize the impact to the trees. If work is done in the growing season, the trees should be watered once per week with a deep slow watering system.

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


