- c. The Commission finds that the building(s) has historic value based on architectural significance, cultural significance, historic significance, as the work/product of an architect of note, its status as a contributing structure in a National Register Historic District, and/or as an intact or rare example of a certain architectural style or method of construction.




### 117-125 W Mifflin

- Commercial building constructed in 1922.
- Architect, Philip M. Homer; rare glazed terra-cotta arcade-form building
- 1997, Keeper of the National Register determined proposed State Street NR district was eligible, with these buildings as contributing
- 2019, Landmarks Commission found these buildings had historic value for its architectural significance, as buildings that the Keeper of the National Register determined are contributing to a proposed National Register historic district, represent the work of an architect of note (Philip M. Homer), and as an intact example of arcade style building that is rare in Madison.
- Staff recommendation aligns with 2019 LC finding.




### 15 N Fairchild

- Commercial building constructed 1928, remodeled 1979
- Preservation file identifies this wing as the mailroom for Wisconsin Power & Light Building, designed by Law, Law and Potter
