Dear City Council:

I am disgusted and dismayed by your recent resolution regarding the events in Israel.

On October 7, Hamas, an avowed terrorist organization whose charter explicitly calls for the extermination of Jews, trespassed across Israel's internationally recognized border and targeted innocent civilians for death and destruction. Hamas beheaded babies, kidnapped children, raped women, burned civilians alive, took hostages, and killed more than 1,400 people. Hamas violated an existing ceasefire with Israel, not for the purpose of fighting against Israeli soldiers - of course, Israel has not occupied any part of Gaza since 2005, so there would be no basis to attack Israel from Gaza in any manner - but to terrorize as many Jewish civilians as possible.

The City Council's reaction to these horrific acts, worse in scale than 9/11 in the U.S., was deafening silence.

It was only after Israel began to undertake a necessary and just response to the mass slaughter of innocent people in its own country that the City Council suddenly felt compelled to weigh in on events halfway across the world. The City Council's "ceasefire" prescription would allow Hamas to remain in power in Gaza, inviting them to attack Jewish civilians again and again indefinitely. The timing and content of the City Council's resolution establish a double standard in favor of terrorists who would unleash the same hell in this community if only it were not protected by distance and military might. Indeed, Hamas also killed and captured American civilians, some of whom are still being held hostage, in its October 7 rampage. The City Council expresses no concern for the fate of its fellow countrymen.

Antisemitic hate crimes have increased exponentially in the U.S. and around the world since October 7. Yet, instead of addressing the significance of these repugnant acts targeting Jews, the City Council takes the "All Lives Matter" approach, drawing a false equivalence between the well-documented rise in antisemitic incidents and hypothetical Islamophobia.

The City Council's resolution makes Jews feel unsafe and unwelcome in their own community. I urge you to withdraw it immediately.
