



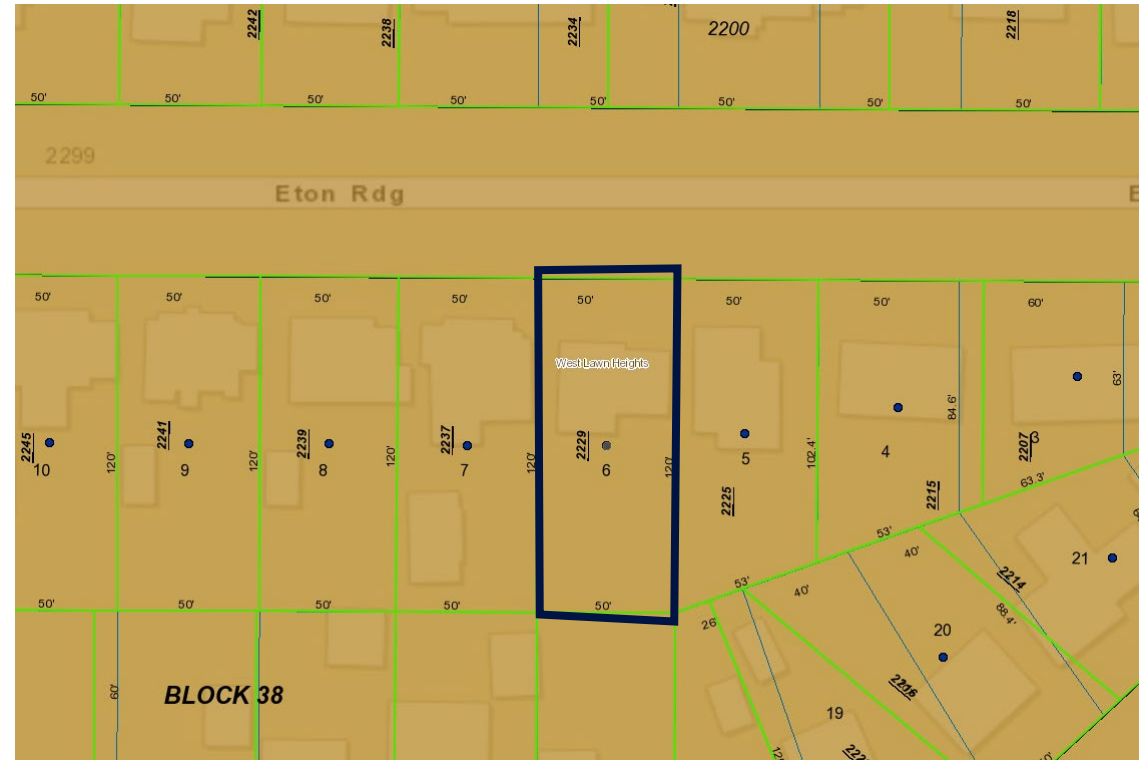

- Clarenbach made significant contributions to the rights of women at the local, state, and national levels
