Re: Proposed Street Reconstruction Project & Public Hearing

The City of Madison is planning the construction of Rolling Way, which is an extension of Atticus Way to Red Arrow Trail in 2024. Enclosed with this letter is a fact sheet with some details on the proposed project. Also enclosed is a notification for the Public Hearing before the Board of Public Works. The date, time and location of the public hearing is on the notification.

This project will involve special assessments to the property listed

above. The property owner will be assessed for all the items included with the construction of Rolling Way which includes earthwork, storm sewer, gravel base, curb and gutter, sidewalk, asphalt pavement, street lighting, pavement marking, and signing.

Below is a preliminary Schedule of Assessments, which shows the estimated costs for your property adjacent to the project. The Schedule of Assessments for all properties adjacent to the project is available on the project website: https://www.cityofmadison.com/engineering/projects/atticus-way, a hard copy can be mailed to you upon request. The frontage of your property to be assessed is listed on the full schedule. After work is complete, a final assessment cost will be calculated based work performed. The final assessment cost, which will be billed after the completion of the project, is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with 5% interest charged on the unpaid balance.

That on WEDNESDAY, MARCH 6, 2024 AT 5:30 P.M., the Board of Public Works will be held remotely and the public can attend using a laptop or call in by phone. If you would like instruction on how to participate, please email boardofpublicworks@cityofmadison.com The Board will consider any objections that may be filed in writing or in person and hear all persons desiring to be heard, and;

That special assessments may be paid over an eight (8) year period, with the owner paying 1/8 of the principal each year plus five (5%) percent interest on the unpaid balance, as determined by the Board of Public Works.

That if the total assessment is paid in full before October 31st in the year that the billing is made, irrespective of project completion, then no interest shall be charged.

Fact and Details Sheet: PROPOSED ROLLING WAY CONSTRUCTION

Project Details – Proposed Work

Sanitary Sewer: The City will not install new sanitary sewer along the street.

Water Main: The City will not install new water main along the street.

Storm Sewer: The City will install new storm infrastructure along the new

street. It will include the installation of one storm inlet and storm sewer pipes along the new street (100% assessable). The new storm sewer infrastructure will be connected to the system that will be installed to the Atticus Way extension in the 4649 Verona Road Private Development Project. There would be no storm infrastructure connecting to Red Arrow Trail.

Street: The City will install new asphalt pavement, gravel base, curb and gutter, and 5' sidewalk (100% assessable). Sidewalk will be installed along both sides of the proposed street. The proposed street will be 28 ft. from face of curb to face of curb, which will allow for travel in both sides of the street. On street parking will be allowed on one side. New pedestrian crossings will be added connecting Rolling Way and Red Arrow Trail. Improvements will include the addition of pedestrian ramps on both sides of Red Arrow Trail and a mill and overlay.

Bus pads: No bus pads will be installed within the project limits.

Street Lights: There will be new street lights installed along Rolling Way. (100% assessable)

Trees: No trees will be removed with the project. Tree pruning in advance of the project is required to reduce the risk of damage to the trees during construction. The City of Madison Forestry Section will perform the necessary work. For certain species, especially oak and elm trees, the pruning must be completed by June 1st to reduce the chance of disease. If additional trees need to be removed, City Engineering will notify the adjacent property owner prior to removal.

Street trees provide many benefits to the City and are considered an important part of the city's infrastructure. Forestry Section staff will evaluate the terrace for new planting sites and potential replacement sites when the project is complete. There is no additional cost to the adjacent property owner for a tree planting. Street trees are typically planted in the spring of the year following the completion of the construction project. Per Madison General Ordinance 10.10, City Forestry determines tree species and planting locations. Residents cannot choose or plant their own tree in the terrace.


Assessments: The project will have special assessments for the street construction. The assessments are a special charge for work being done that has a direct benefit to the property. The preliminary assessments are mailed during the design phase and will give the property owner an estimated cost due after construction is complete. The final assessment bill will be mailed in 2025 to the adjacent property owner and be calculated based on bid prices and measured quantities. The property payment options include payment by lump sum or over 8 years with 5 percent interest.

Construction Schedule & Impacts

Tentative Schedule: This project is scheduled to be bid in spring of 2024. It is expected that the project will take approximately 3 months to complete between August 2024 and October 2024. Traffic will be maintained along Red Arrow Trail and Atticus Way during the project.

Traffic Impacts: Rolling Way will be closed to pedestrian, bicycles, and vehicles until construction is complete. Traffic along Red Arrow Trail will be maintained.

Water Shut-offs: There are no planned water shut-offs. While unlikely, emergency shut offs are possible if the existing main is damaged during construction. Affected properties are notified as soon as possible.

Street Installation Assessment: The rate for the street installation is calculated based on the total estimated costs divided by the total length of the street work (length of the new street (Rolling Way) plus the length of work on Red Arrow Trail) divided by 2 (each parcel pays for half the street along their frontage). The rate is applied to the lot along the east side of Rolling Way (4685 Atticus Way). The City is not assessing the parcel on the west side of the street.

Storm Sewer Installation Assessment: The rate for the storm sewer installation is calculated based on the total estimated costs divided by the length of the new street (Rolling Way) divided by 2 (each parcel pays for half the storm sewer installation). The rate is applied to the lot along the east side of Rolling Way (4685 Atticus Way). The City is not assessing the parcel on the west side of the street.

Street Lighting Installation Assessment: The rate for street lighting is calculated based on the total estimated costs divided by the net linear frontage for parcels that have access to Rolling Way.
