I'm opposed to adding a sidewalk on Doncaster for many reasons. But will just make comments related to transportation.

IF we have one sidewalk, please consider parking to be on the other side.

1. It is lopsided and will be chaotic to have both parking and pedestrians on the same side of the street.

As for the logic that you don't want people to have to walk across the street - No matter which side is the parking side, 50% will cross the street to their house and all drivers get out in the street.

2. 4230 has 3 boys under 5. If parking's on the south side, they'll be crossing the street a lot, and that WILL be dangerous.

3. Doncaster is filled with parked cars. I'm concerned there won't be enough space for all the cars, and they'll be snugged up to driveways, making it difficult to get in & out.

4. With so many cars in the street, snow removal and leaf pickup has been a problem with parking on both sides. Without alternate parking, the snow won't get removed on one side all winter.
