

Item 5 on the Sept 5, 2006 CC agenda:

Paragraph one:

The second sentence will read:

“The following five shelters will be removed and will have new shelters installed.”

Paragraph three (after the list of five shelters):

1. Strike the first sentence entirely.
2. Strike “However” at the beginning of the second sentence
3. The third sentence should read, “The Council will have the opportunity to award a contract for 5, 6, or 7 shelters depending on bids received and available funds.”
4. Add the following sentence:

“The two remaining shelters will remain in service until the Council awards a contract, at which time a decision will be made whether to retain the shelters until funds are available to replace them.”

Paragraph five (below numbers 6 and 7):

Strike the word, “However” at the beginning of the sentence.
