Budget Meetings: Hour 3

Public comment continues as we move into the third hour of the budget hearings.

Looking ahead to the Capital Budget, it's evident that the weeks since the Mayor released his budget have been a time of drawing battle lines for Madison's alders. Most of the amendments come from two diametrically-opposed factions of Alders.

Alders Robbie Webber, Brenda Konkel and Marsha Rummel all alternately have a hand in a smattering of amendments that would delay seven major road projects by a year, for a combined savings of \$3.7 million in 2009.

Meanwhile, Alders Jed Sanborn, Judy Compton and Thuy Pham-Remmelle are behind an amendment that strikes \$100,000 worth of funding from the Renewable Energy Project. Sanborn, Pham-Remmelle and Alder Libby Monsonmade a bold move to remove \$250,000 from the budget that was intended to jumpstart the Central Park project between 2009 and 2011. And it was Sanborn, Pham-Remmelle, Monson and Alder Michael Schumacher who got together to quash \$120,000 from the municipal art fund, which has already drawn protest from several members of the public tonight.
