WHEREAS, on April 21, 2009, the Common Council approved Ordinance ID #14165 and the associated rate changes; and

WHEREAS, said rates for on-street parking meter rates and hoods, and Parking Rate changes will take effect on June 1, 2009;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the attached Madison Parking Utility Parking Rate Schedule effective June 1, 2009, reflects the official rate schedule of the Madison Parking Utility as previously adopted by the Transit and Parking Commission and the Common Council.

Notes

- (a) The Evening/Weekend Maximum rate applies to cashiered parking during the following time periods ...
 - Hours parked after 6 p.m. weeknights (until 5 a.m. the following day); and
 - Hours parked on Saturdays/Sundays (from 5 a.m. until 5:00 a.m. the following day)

Parking ramps can be used free of charge between 9 p.m. and 7 a.m. on days when a snow emergency has been declared.

Coupons: Businesses and individuals can request coupons for distribution to customers/clients. We invoice for the value of *redeemed* coupons

plus a 10% admin fee.

- (b) All ramps and surface lots are enforced 24/7.
- (c) Competitive Pricing -- UW/Kohl Center/Camp Randall Special Event pricing = \$15; Alliant Center Special Event pricing = \$5 (5800 stalls).
- (d) On-street meters are enforced from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Note: Per Sept 2008 Ordinance change, the rate for NON-metered two-hour and one-hour

parking zones will go from \$2 to \$5 per day.

- (e) Multi-space meters will be phased-in during 2009 at \$.20/hour more than the "single pole" rate (e.g., \$1.70/hr on-street, \$1.45/hr Buckeye Lot)
- (f) Eligible carpoolers qualify for the (discounted) Monthly Resident rate and are entitled to immediate occupancy in select ramps.
- (g) To better ensure continuation of our "100% Occupancy Rate" for monthly parking, parkers will be required to provide 30-days notice of termination

(the Parking Utility currently provides parkers with 30-days notice of termination)

(h) Residential Parking Permit (RP3) Program - we are discontinuing pro-ration of the permit cost (e.g., presently, a permit purchased Sept-Dec costs

\$21, the full-year rate; a permit purchased Jan-Apr costs \$14; etc.)
