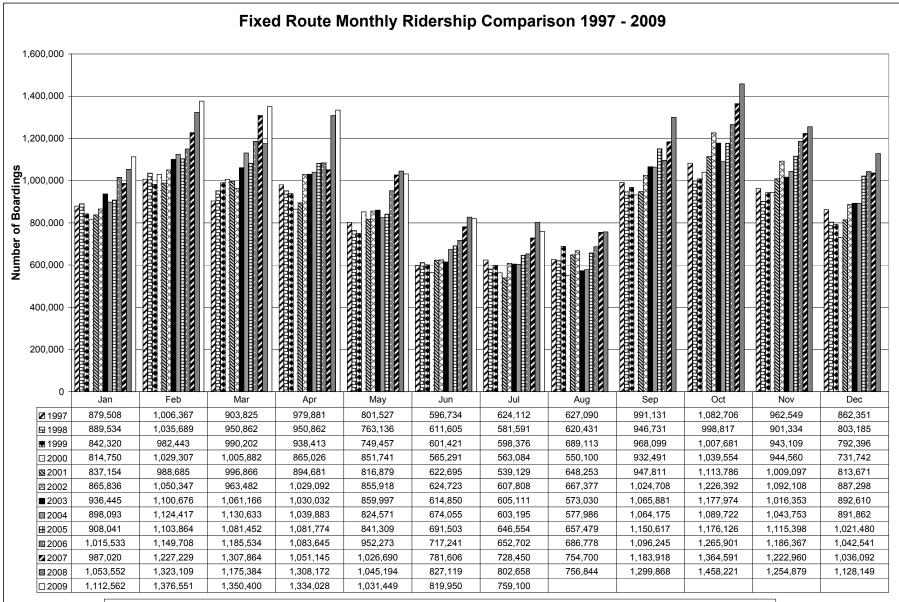

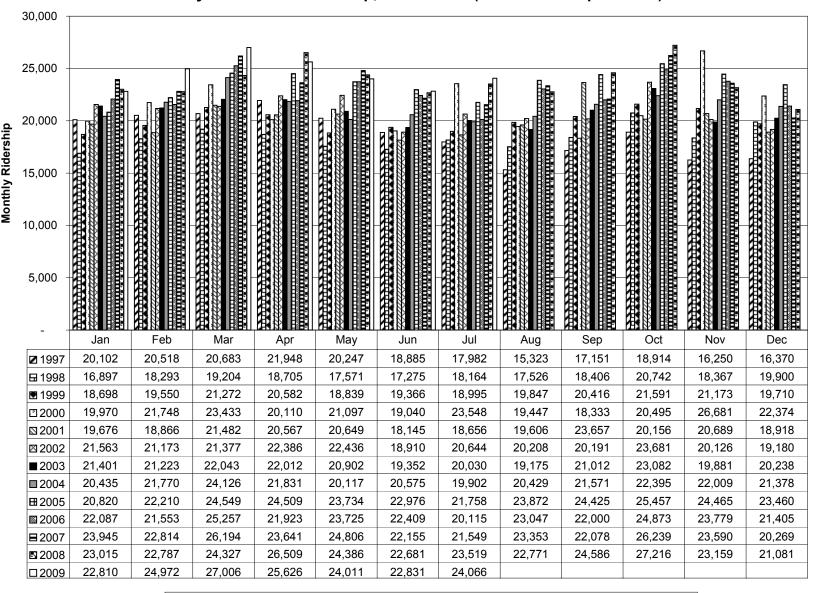

# **Background**

The Badger Bus Depot is soon to be demolished to make way for an approved mixed use redevelopment on that property. The Common Council directed the Mayor's office and appropriate City staff to study the short-term solutions to the intercity bus service issue and report back to the Council by September 1<sup>st</sup>.

## Report

There are two intercity bus carriers impacted by this redevelopment project, Badger Bus and Greyhound. They are each pursuing different strategies to meet their needs and the needs of their customers.

The University of Wisconsin has indicated their preference for no additional bus parking spaces or schedules on Langdon Street, as it is at capacity now. The City is not planning to grant any additional bus stops for that location.

Badger Bus will be using stops at the UW Madison (as they have done in the past – they are not adding pull-ins or outs on Langdon), at Kelly's Market on West Washington near their old depot, and at the Dutch Mill Park and Ride Lot. To accomplish this, they have applied for and are seeking permission from the City of Madison to use the stop at Kelly's Market and they have notified the City of Madison of their intent to use Dutch Mill and to enter into an arrangement with Metro similar to the Van Galder/Metro agreement. Their published schedules do not conflict with Van Galder, as confirmed with both bus companies and Metro, therefore efforts are underway to enter into a contract to formalize the arrangement at Dutch Mill.

Greyhound is in the process of securing the use of a vacant former restaurant building near one of Metro's Transfer Points to allow customers of Greyhound and Metro to transfer relatively conveniently. Greyhound reports that they have no other bus stop locations planned in Madison at this time, and that they anticipate working on their transition without any disruption in service.

The parties, Metro Transit and Madison Area Technical College (MATC), by this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) acknowledge and agree that contract negotiations for the unlimited ride pass agreement for the 2009-2010 academic year are proceeding constructively as of the date of this MOU. However, the parties have not reached a final agreement. School is starting soon and passes for the unlimited ride pass program will be distributed the week of August 17, 2009.

Other terms and conditions related to billing, timeliness of payments and other administrative terms will follow the previous agreement, signed by the parties and executed by the Mayor of the City of Madison on March 24, 2009, will stand for the duration of this MOU.
