Description of Expansion Plans: The Mallards are working on hosting "Ducktoberfest" on October 3, 2009. The event will be a family oriented Oktoberfest event with food, soda & beer for sale to fans. Would run from 2pm-8pm (Music & Beer sales would stop at 7:30). Parks Department has already approved the event. Both Alders are supportive, with the caveat that the ALRC approves a Change of Licensed Premise. We would operate kids games, have face painters, entertainers, etc to give it a family entertainment feel. We anticipate a crowd of around 4,000 people for the event, but obviously weather will play a huge roll in the amount of people that turnout. Mallards would provide ushering staff (same as used for Mallards events) to help in crowd control. We have contacted Captain McL ay from the North Police District & he has recommended that we hire 6 off-duty officers to provide security at the event & this is already being scheduled. To allow us to serve this additional attendance we would like to add up to 2 additional beer locations in the outfield area for this event. It is important to note that the Duck Blind (all you can eat & drink) deck area would not be available for this event & that beer prices would be increased to \$4.\$5 for a 16oz glass. I have attached a map indicating approximately where these locations would be for this event. We would continue to pour beer from 2 of our existing locations in the stadium.
