## Full committee

## **Indicators**

I think each sub committee would be best suited to determine its own indicators in each of its areas of focus, however the principles that drive the selection of indicators should be determined by the full committee.

## Outreach

While I see the logic behind splitting outreach into each subcommittee, I believe there are two good reasons to leave it whole, and put it in Private.

- -Outreach would be best tackled as a holistic subject. The educational and input/feedback processes will be best organized by one cohesive group of people.
- -The vast majority of the content that outreach is concerned with will be targeted to the subjects of the Private sub-committee. The educational component will be focused on individuals and orgs. The input and feedback components will be targeted to individuals

and orgs. Though we are concerned with opinions on Public matters, it's to a far lesser extent than Private.
