In the case of the granting or license or transfer of a Class A or B license or the granting of the modification of a sidewalk café with a Class B license, notice of the time and a date of the meeting of the Alcohol License Review Committee shall be sent by the Clerk to the alderperson of the district in which the licensed premises will be located and to the recognized neighborhood association or business association representing the area in which the licensed premises will be located, if any."
