

TO THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL:

RE: Recommendation: Place on File Without Prejudice
Ordinance / Legistar File No. 07732

This ordinance proposes to amend various sections of the zoning code with respect to the number of required parking spaces for various uses. On January 8, 2008, the Common Council passed a motion by Ald. Gruber, the author of the ordinance, to refer it to the City Attorney's Office. Our understanding was that Ald. Gruber wished to make additional changes in the ordinance. Ald. Gruber never subsequently contacted our office with a request for changes. Ald. Gruber has since left the Common Council.

Now, the City is in the process of rewriting its zoning code, which will consider, among other things, the number of parking spaces necessary for different uses. Because the matter to be considered by this ordinance will be covered by the zoning code rewrite, and because there has been no action on this ordinance for over a year, and because the sponsor is no longer on the Common Council, the City Attorney recommends that the matter be placed on file without prejudice.
