The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:			
Subsection (15) of Section 38.07 entitled "General Restrictions" of the Madison General Ordinances is created to read as follows:			
"(15) <u>Establishments Selling Motor Vehicle Fuels</u> . No new "Class B" license or "Class A" license authorizing the retail sale of intoxicating liquors shall be issued to any establishment which also sells motor vehicle fuels, unless the licensee agrees to the license condition that the establishment will limit the sales of intoxicating liquors solely to wine."
