

You are being sent this letter to notify you of the *revised schedule of assessments* for properties on Darwin Road. The project will involve sidewalk installed at 100% property owner cost. Attached to this letter is a revised Schedule of Assessments, which shows revised estimated costs for each property adjacent to the project.

The attached Schedule of Assessments shows a breakdown of costs for each sidewalk construction item and the total estimated cost to be assessed to each adjacent property owner. Please contact Eric Dundee, the Project Engineer, at 266-4913, with any questions regarding the street reconstruction.

Temporary Construction Easements/Retaining Walls

Temporary construction easements or retaining walls will be required for this project. The property owner has the option of either granting a temporary construction grading permit or having a split block retaining wall installed. A copy of the temporary construction grading permit is attached for reference. If a split block retaining wall is chosen by the property owner, the estimate assessment for the retaining wall is \$50.00 per face foot of retaining wall installed. Please contact Eric Dundee, the Project Engineer, at 266-4913, with any questions regarding the owner options for this portion of the project. If no contact is made by June 11, 2010, it will be assumed the property owner would like a split block retaining wall.

Special Assessments - General

A special assessment is a special charge for work that the City is planning to complete. The attached Schedule of Assessments shows an *estimate* of the property owners' share of the project costs based upon the City's assessment policy. After the project is bid, and work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on bid prices and work actually performed. The final assessment, which will be billed after the completion of the project, is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with 3.5% interest charged on the unpaid balance.
