DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: This ordinance reduces the number of Plan Commission members serving on the Long-Range Transportation Planning Committee from 3 to 2 and allows for the appointment of an at-large member to serve on the LRTPC.

The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

Subdivision (b) entitled "Composition" of Subsection (7) entitled "Long-Range Transportation Planning Committee" of Section 3.14 entitled "Department of Transportation" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

"(b) Composition. The Long-Range Transportation Planning Committee shall consist of eleven (11) voting members to serve without compensation consisting of two (2) members of the Pedestrian/Bicycle/Motor Vehicle Commission, two (2) members of the Transit and Parking Commission, one (1) member of the Board of Public Works, ~~three~~two (~~3~~2) members of the Plan Commission, one (1) member of the Dane County Board of Supervisors who resides in Madison, ~~and~~ two (2) City representatives of the Metropolitan Planning Organization for Transportation Planning, and one at-large member. Of the eleven (11) Committee members, three (3) shall also be members of the Common Council. The Mayor may also designate one (1) alternate."
