The City of Madison is proposing to improve Syene Road in 2011. The limits of the proposed project are on Syene Road from Post Road to Stewart Street. This project involves special assessments to owners of property on the project. You are being sent this letter to notify you of the public hearing before the Board of Public Works at the above referenced date, time, and location. City Engineering will be making a presentation at the meeting, followed by the public hearing. Attached to this letter is a schedule of assessments that contains the estimated cost for each property on the project.

The proposed improvements for the street reconstruction include installing concrete curb and gutter, resurfacing of the existing pavement, installing concrete drive aprons, and constructing storm sewer. Sanitary sewer and water main work is not anticipated, but spot repairs will be done as necessary.

Street Improvements

Within these project limits, there have been significant erosion issues along Syene Road. To address that, the City is proposing to improve the street with concrete curb and gutter. With this project, it is also proposed that Syene Road be widened from its current width of 21 feet to a width of 40 feet. The curb and gutter and additional pavement width will be added to the existing road, and the existing pavement will be resurfaced. Concrete driveway aprons will also be installed. A portion of the asphalt driveways will likely need to be removed and replaced to keep the driveway at an adequate slope, and to match into the new concrete apron. Sidewalk is not proposed with this project.

The cost of the street improvements will be shared by the City and the property owners adjoining the reconstruction. Since Syene Rd. is not currently improved, the entire cost of the concrete curb and gutter and 4 ft. of pavement will be assessed to the adjacent property owners, as will the concrete driveway aprons. The City and property owner will share the cost of removing and replacing the asphalt driveways on a 50/50 basis. The City assumes the entire cost of the improvements to the storm sewer and the remaining pavement width. The attached Schedule of Assessments shows a breakdown of costs for each of the street reconstruction items and the total estimated cost to be assessed to each adjacent property owner. Sanitary Sewer Main and Water Main

The sanitary sewer main and laterals within the limits of this project were constructed in 1981, and it is expected to be in good condition. Therefore, work on the sanitary sewer is not anticipated with this project.

The water main between Post Rd. and Watson Ave. was installed in 1981, and the water main between Watson M:\DESIGN\STREETS\DGN\53W1104\Project Info\Assessment\Syene ASMT LTR.doc

Ave. and Stewart St. was installed in 1961. Similar to the sanitary sewer, these portions of water main are in good condition, and work on the water main is not proposed with this project.

Storm Sewer

Storm sewer main, leads, and inlets will be installed as part of this project. The ditches will be filled, and the storm sewer system will facilitate the drainage within the project limits. This work is not assessed to property owners. Max Conway is the storm sewer designer for this project, and you may contact him at 261-9127.

Impact on Trees and Landscaping

During construction, it will be necessary to trim tree limbs and/or roots to accommodate the construction. Some tree and brush removals will be necessary with this construction; however, every effort will be made to save as many existing trees as possible. Several tree removals are expected with this project. If you have concerns regarding the removals please contact City Engineering.

Please note that construction will also have an impact on existing flower gardens and other plantings adjacent to the road. With the nature of this work, property owners should anticipate that most of the terrace will be disturbed; therefore, any plantings or special landscaping features that an owner wishes to save from damage should be removed from the terrace area prior to the start of construction.

Assessments - General

A special assessment is a special charge for work that the City is planning to complete. The attached schedule of assessments shows an estimate of the property owners' share of the project based upon the City's assessment policy. When the project is bid, and work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on work actually performed. The final assessment is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with 3.5% interest charged on the unpaid balance.
