Suggestions to Madison Ped/Bike Committee Concerning the Verona Road Project

1. CROSSING VERONA ROAD: Please <u>ask WisDOT to build a ped/bike bridge over Verona</u> Road at the <u>Beltline</u>.



This crossing is now 13 lanes. Under the improvement it will be 18 lanes. Increasing the size of the islands, which is what WisDOT proposes, does not solve the problem. An 18-lane atgrade crossing is not a safe crossing no matter what the size of the islands.

2. LOCATION OF THE BELTLINE FRONTAGE ROAD: Please support Option B and oppose Option A.

Option B keeps the frontage road next to the Beltline where it should be. Option A would dip the road down toward homes. Saving several business buildings is not a good tradeoff for residents.

3. RELOCATION OF THE VERONA FRONTAGE ROAD NEAR WALGREEN'S: The <u>proposed</u> relocation is extremely dangerous and needs to be rethought.

Encircling Walgreen's, a strip mall, and a cash for titles business means that pedestrians and motorists won't be able to see each other. There will be much more traffic on the street – Atticus Way – than there is now since it is now a deadend. Pedestrians – including many kids – will still cross in the middle of the block. Frontage Road traffic will be brought right up against the City-supported low-income Avalon Village, making it less desireable.

4. MANY BIKE/PED/MOTORIST CONFLICTS INTRODUCED BY THE CARLING DRIVE CONNECTION TO ALLIED AND THE FEEPORT ROAD CONNECTION UNDER VERONA ROAD: All conflicts could be avoided by retaining the current configuration of bikeways, sidewalks, and roads, but if either road is put in, great care will have to be exercised in designing and controlling the intersections.



Currently both routes are bike and pedestrian only. To add roads and intersections adds many chances for serious accidents. This is particularly true because of a big grade change between Carling Drive and Allied Drive.

Signing should note that both the Southwest Commuter Trail and the Military Ridge Trail can be accessed via the new Carling Drive connection.

5. BIKEPATH CROSSINGS OF PD: Please join Fitchburg in suggesting grade-separated crossings of PD for the Cannonball and Southwest Commuter/Badger State Trail and Dane Co. in asking for such bridges for the Military Ridge & Cannonball.

The Cannonball and Badger State Trail both are "mid-block" crossings of a very busy 4-lane PD. They deserve grade-separated crossings both for convenience and safety's sake.

6. PED/BIKE CROSSING OF VERONA ROAD AT PD. Please support Fitchburg's request for a grade-separated crossing of Verona Road at PD to allow safe access to the Military Ridge Trail for people living west of Verona Road.
