Page	Section	Comment
12	Paragraph 1	This section states: "Neighborhood plans may or may not be adopted as part of the Comprehensive Plan." However on page 38, K1 we find: "Neighborhood plans are supplements to the Comprehensive Plan but are not adopted as part of the Comprehensive Plan." This is confusing if not contradictory. I agree with the sentence on page 38.
27	E.2.a	Last sentence is ambiguous. Most of the paragraph is about staff facilitating training. Last sentence doesn't mention training and seems to say staff are to "Ensure that meetings are conducted in a respectful manner" I agree with this notion, but if this is what is meant, it should be more clearly noted. One could argue that the text now simply provides that Staff should train committee members to be respectful, etc.
29	F1	I think with use of "require in the second and third sentence that the "consider" in the first sentence could be "require" as well unless this first recommendation is controversial in a way I do not see.
