At an Informational Presentation to the Plan Commission on November 22, 2010, St. Paul's University Catholic Center presented its plan to demolish the existing St. Paul's Chapel and adjacent Student Center to build a new St. Paul Catholic Center and Residential College at 723 State Street. The existing church, originally built in 1909, was significantly remodeled in 1967 as a predominately concrete structure and connected to the adjacent wood frame structure which serves as a student center.
