Re: Proposed Sanitary Sewer and Water Main

The City of Madison is proposing to construct new sanitary sewer and water main as well as laterals on Prairie Hill Road from County Highway 'M' to South View Road with the ongoing Pleasant View Road/ County Highway 'M' project. Included with letter is a copy of the plan set (Exhibit A) showing the approximate location where the City intends to install your new sanitary and water laterals. The water laterals will be located in the same trench as the sanitary laterals. If there is a different preferable location for your new sanitary and water laterals, feel free to contact Mark Moder of my staff at 261-9250 or by email at mmoder@cityofmadison.com.

Enclosed with this letter are a Notice of Public Hearing for the proposed sanitary and water work and a Schedule of Assessments showing the estimated cost to each of the property owners within the construction project limits.

## Impact on Trees and Landscaping

During construction, it may be necessary to trim tree limbs and clear brush in order to accommodate the construction of the new sewer and water lateral(s). Tree conflicts are often encountered with underground utility improvements. Tree growth and vegetation encountered in the Right of Way during the lateral installations will be removed by the contractor. Please review the plan to determine if the lateral(s) are where you would like them to be. Placing lathe or a clearly marked stake is another option if that would work better than marking the up the plan.

#### **Payment of Assessments**

The sewer and water assessment is payable in either a lump sum payment or over a period of 8 years with 2.5% interest charged on the unpaid balance.


