Strategic Priorities

- **1.** PHMDC will seek to more fully understand and develop programming that addresses the social and economic determinants of health, focusing especially on **health inequity**.
- 2. PHMDC will build capacity to translate data into action through community-based research.
- **3.** PHMDC will **evaluate all public health programs for effectiveness and efficiency** using standard evidence-based measures and best practices assuring that programs are in line with community health assessments and community health improvement plans.
- **4.** PHMDC will build and strengthen **partnerships** with other local government agencies, health care institutions, academia and community-based organizations.

Actions

Division of Environmental Health

- 1. Address licensed establishments according to complexity and risk
- 2. Create collaborative strategies to reduce rural and urban hazardous waste
- 3. Incorporate relevant built environment factors into community health assessment
- 4. Define role of PHMDC relative to Dane County air quality

Division of Community Health

- 1. Advance neighborhood capacity building and revitalization strategies
- **2.** Incorporate community health assessment and other relevant data into program prioritization and other decisions
- **3.** Facilitate coordinator of community-based research and programming

Division of Administration

- **1.** Design and implement social marketing strategies to support priority public health objectives
