 Transit Director- Green Bay
 - Free rides are available on fixed routes for SC veterans showing VA, SC ID Card, do not include para-transit.
 - Findings: Negligible costs with positive feedback.
 - Green Bay Mayor endorsed this initiative
- 2. Information from **Duluth-Superior Transit Authority** Dennis Jensen and Jim Heilig
 - Minnesota does have this program available statewide. The WI Veterans
 Board Legislative Committee may be interested in getting this established in
 WI.
 - Duluth-Superior Metro also has a similar program, POC Transit Director Dennis Jensen 218) 722-4426 provided information that this is a cost of about \$1,000 year from 1,000 SC Disabled veteran riders. Does not include para-transit.
