



### Unique Characteristics to be Conserved


- Compact, pedestrian-friendly
- Small-scale, low-rise character
- Consistent "rhythm" of buildings on narrow lots
- Variety of uses
- Variety in physical characteristics
- Local, small-scale commercial-employment uses
- Canopy street trees







# NCD Study Area Current Zoning




# NCD Recommendations Rec. 1: New Base Zoning Districts




# NCD Recommendations Rec. 2. Create Neighborhood Conservation Overlay




#### A. Limit lot combinations







### B. Prohibit "Through Lots"



C. Maximum Height = 2 stories or 30 feet, except where specified




D. Define allowable front setbacks by block to conserve existing variety



- E. Reduce minimum usable open space requirements for lots under 5,000 square feet
- F. Reduce rear yard requirements for lots shallower than 100 feet.




# NCD Rec. 2.2: Overlay Requirements Transition Areas

## **Implementation**

- •Rezone properties to recommended base zoning districts upon adoption of the new zoning code
- •Common Council *may* initiate Zoning Map amendment to create NCD overlay
