Program Context

- Loss of intercity bus service in Wisconsin
 - Decreased connectivity in rural areas
 - Lack of convenient intercity bus connections between metropolitan areas
- Lack of connections between intercity bus and other modes of transportation
- Limited federal funding 53 I I (f) Program
- Inability to contract directly with intercity bus providers

The Intercity Bus Assistance Program addresses the aforementioned challenges with the following objectives:

 Improve connectivity to/between major metropolitan areas that currently lack convenient or direct intercity bus connections

Facilitate intermodal connections
