Windstream/KDL will be extending its fiber optic network in the City of Madison beginning in August and through September of 2011. This work will be done to complete a new fiber build to provide service to Anchor Bank located at 301 Junction Rd in the City of Madison, WI.

There will be a public hearing before the City of Madison Board of Public Works, on Wednesday, August 3rd at 5:30 p.m. in room 108 of the city county building, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Madison, WI.

Contractors hired by Windstream/KDL will bury the new fiber optic line within the road right of way limits at the following locations:

- 1. Starting at the handhole located at the southwest corner of S Rosa Rd and Mineral Point Rd will place fiber optic cable going North across Mineral Point Rd to the north side right of way will turn and continue west to HWY 12.
- 2. Turning north at the north bound on ramp to US HWY 12 will continue on the east side right of way for approx 1600'.
- 3. Placement will then go west crossing US HWY 12 and turn north in the west side right of way and continue to the rear of the Anchor Bank property and then turn west on to their property.

The fiber optic cable will be directional bored in the public road right of way.

Restoration of any damage within the limits of the project in the right of way will be restored in accordance with the City of Madison standard specifications.
