CenturyTel will be extending its fiber optic network in the City of Madison beginning in August and through September of 2011. This work will be done to complete a new fiber build to provide new service to Meriter Hospital located at 2650 Novation Parkway in The Town of Madison, WI.

There will be a public hearing before the City of Madison Board of Public Works, on Wednesday, August 3rd at 5:30 p.m. in room 108 of the City County Building, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Madison, WI.

Contractors hired by CenturyTel will bury the new fiber optic line within the road right of way limits at the following locations:

- 1. Beginning at an existing handhole located on the north side of 1111 Applegate Rd CenturyTel will place one fiber optic cable along the north Right of Way to the east to reach US Hwy 14 / S. Park St.
- 2. Placement will then continue south along the west Right of Way of US Hwy 14/S. Park St to reach the Wisconsin and Southern Railroad where the new fiber will be bored under the elevated train bridge to reach the east Right of Way of US Hwy 14/S. Park St. Placement will then continue south to the southern property line of EFLEX located at 2740 Ski Lane.
- 3. Turning east placement will continue off US Hwy 14 / S. Park St Right of Way and across Oregon Rd to the east Right of Way of Oregon where placement will turn north to Novation Parkway and then east along the southen Right of Way of Novation Parkway.
- 4. On the south side of Novation Parkway and in front of Meriter Hospital located at 2650 Novation Parkway placement will turn north to reach an existing customer handhole that will be utilized to gain building entry.

The fiber optic cable and/or will be directional bored and trenched in the public road right of way.

Restoration of any damage within the limits of the project in the right of way will restored in accordance with the City of Madison standard specifications. All damage done to terrace area will be restored with black dirt and seed.
