

Coast to Coast by Velomobile

This has never happened before! Imagine this: It's the summer of 2011. 24 velomobiles making their way from the Pacific to the Atlantic. European velomobile riders bring their machines over to North America to do the grand tour across the continent together, enjoying the landscape and meeting their fellow riders. That is the one side of Roll Over America. The other is about making the journey as a group, meeting new friends and seeing many interesting places.

This tour has never been done by a group of velomobiles. Never have so many European velomobile riders come to America. Most Americans have never seen a velomobile on the
