Dear Mr. Martin,

I am writing to you regarding tonight's agenda item 23445 the 6854 Stockbridge Drive plan for constructing 86 Multi-family Units in Three Buildings. 3rd Ald. Dist.

I have serious concerns with this plan. I own the property at 409 Bailey Drive which is a one block street which intersects with Stockbridge Drive. The planned apartments would be extremely close to my home. My concerns are as follows:

- 1) The proposed density (units per acre) from the original plan of the property. The units per acre have increased dramatically in the first stage of this project and I believe strongly that this piece of the plan should then have less density to stay within the original density plan for the neighborhood.
- 2) The proposed density would dramatically increase traffic flow on already narrow streets creating many safety concerns. In addition, one driveway planned for exit on Stockbridge Dr. is in a very bad location. It is right after a bend in the street further adding to the danger.
- 3) The plan does not include enough off-street parking for the tenants. Too many cars will thus be parking along Stockbridge Drive, leaving the driving area too narrowed to allow for two-way traffic. This would further cause congestion and create more safety issues for drivers and pedestrians. We have a great number of people who walk and jog in this area so this pedestrian traffic will also increase with the units planned.
- 4) The green space in front of the buildings facing Stockbridge Drive should be enlarged to fit the profile of the neighborhood. This is a very pleasant, well planted and maintained neighborhood, and without this green space and good plantings the buildings could become a large neighborhood eyesore.

I trust you will take my concerns forward for serious consideration by the Urban Design Commission to alter the current plans.
