Report to the Library Board September 2011

Ebooks: Interesting numbers from the first six months of 2011:

Wonder how many digital books are being checked out (i.e, downloaded) by Madison library users? Through the end of July, people living in Madison checked out 18,471 ebooks and e-audio, which is 39% of the total number of digital items checked out in all the South Central Library System libraries. The use of ebooks is growing rapidly, and this has prompted action by the Wisconsin Interlibrary Loan Service (WiLS) and all the public libraries in the state to collaborate in cooperatively developing a million dollar ebook collection for downloading by anyone in the state with a library card. Madison staff Molly Warren is on the committee to select a vendor, and Mary Knapp is a major selector for the statewide ebook collection.

Annual Resolution exempting MPL from the Dane County Library Tax
