TO: Property owners within the Fish Hatchery Road Assessment District (Street Lighting) - 2012

In the next month, the Board of Public Works and the Madison Common Council will consider plans and assessment schedules to fund new street lights on Fish Hatchery Road. The new street lights are planned to be installed in the median from Emil Street to approximately 140 south of Catalpa Road, and from north of Culmen Street to approximately 300 feet north of Carver Street. These new street lights will have energy efficient LED (Light Emitting Diodes) light fixtures. Only properties with frontages along the roadway segments these new street lights are being installed on are included in the assessment schedule. The estimated cost to install the street lights less the anticipated federal funding is \$42,006.77.

The method of assessments to property owners is based on front footage, factored for usage. Single family lots have a factor of 1.0; multifamily lots have a factor of 1.5; and commercial lots have a factor of 2.0.
