Dear Mr. Marty;

The one-lot certified survey combining property located at 3502 Monroe Street, Section 28, Township 7N, Range 9E, City of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, is hereby **conditionally approved**. The site was recently rezoned PUD-GDP-SIP (Planned Unit Development–General Development Plan–Specific Implementation Plan). The conditions of approval from the reviewing agencies to be satisfied before final approval and recording of the CSM are:

Please contact Janet Dailey, City Engineering Division, at 261-9688 if you have questions regarding the following nine (9) conditions:

- 1. The existing platted building set back line shall be properly released and removed prior to recording of the CSM and issuance of building permits as proposed.
- 2. In the event that the City of Madison encounters soil or groundwater contamination associated with BRRTS #03-13-152094 while doing adjacent utility or street work, the responsible party will reimburse the City for the additional disposal costs. Coordinate site contamination matters with Brynn Bemis, City Engineering 267-1986 or bbemis@cityofmadison.com.
- 3. The developer shall enter into a City/Developer agreement for the installation of public improvements required to serve this project. The developer shall be required to provide deposits to cover City labor and materials and surety to cover the cost of construction. The developer shall meet with the City Engineer to schedule preparation of the plans and the agreement. The City Engineer will not sign off on this CSM without the agreement executed by the developer.
- 4. The following note shall be placed on the Certified Survey Map: "No changes in drainage patterns associated with development on any or all lots within this CSM shall be allowed without prior approval of the City Engineer."
- 5. The following note shall be added to the CSM: "All lots created by this certified survey map are individually responsible for compliance with Chapter 37 of the Madison General Ordinances in regard to storm water management at the time they develop."
- 6. A minimum of 2 working days prior to requesting City Engineering Division signoff on the CSM, the applicant shall contact Janet Dailey (261-9688) to obtain the final stormwater utility charges that are

due and payable prior to subdivision of the properties. The stormwater utility charges (as all utility charges) are due for the previous months of service. All charges shall be cleared prior to the land division (and subsequent obsolesces of the existing parcel).

- 7. All outstanding Madison Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) and City of Madison sanitary sewer connection charges are due and payable prior to City Engineering Division signoff, unless otherwise collected with a Developer's/ Subdivision Contract. Contact Janet Dailey (261-9688) to obtain the final MMSD billing a minimum of 2 working days prior to requesting City Engineering signoff.
- 8. Wisconsin Administrative Code A-E 7.08 identifies when Public Land System (PLS) tie sheets must be filed with the Dane County Surveyor's office. The developer's surveyor and/or applicant must submit copies of required tie sheets or condition reports for all monuments, including center of sections of record, used in this survey, to Eric Pederson, City Engineering Division. If a new tie sheet is not required under A-E 7.08, Engineering requests a copy of the latest tie sheet on record with Dane County Surveyor's office. The applicant shall identify monument types on all PLS corners included on the plat or CSM. Note: Land tie to two PLS corners required.
- 9. City of Madison Environmental Projects Staff have reviewed the subject site and determined that a Phase I ESA will be required of the applicant. The applicant shall provide 1 digital and 2 hard copies of an ASTM Phase I ESA prepared by an environmental professional. Staff review of this Phase I ESA will determine if a further investigative Phase II ESA is also required. Please submit any relevant Phase I and Phase II ESAs to Brynn Bemis (267-1986, bbemis@cityofmadison.com) for further review.

Please contact Dennis Cawley, Madison Water Utility, at 261-9243 if you have questions about the following item:

10. Note: All operating private wells shall be identified and permitted by the Water Utility in accordance with MGO 13.21. All unused private wells shall be abandoned in accordance with MGO13.21.

Please note that the City's Office of Real Estate Services is reviewing the report of title provided with this survey and may have comments. That office will send any comments to you by fax or e-mail. If you have any questions, please contact ORES at 266-4222 for more information.

A resolution approving the CSM and authorizing the City to sign it and any other documents related to the proposed land division will be approved by the Common Council on <u>September 6</u>, 2011.

As soon as the comments and conditions have been satisfied as verified with a completed affidavit form (attached), the original along with the revised Certified Survey Map, with all signatures and approvals from the reviewing agencies, shall be brought to this office for final signoff. You or your client may then record the certified survey at the Dane County Register of Deeds. For information on recording procedures and fees, contact the Register of Deeds at 266-4141.

Prior to City Engineering final sign-off by the main office of the CSM, the final CSM shall be submitted to the Engineering Division Surveyor/ Land Records Coordinator for final technical review and approval. This submittal must occur a minimum of two working days prior to final Engineering Division signoff. E-mail submittal of the final CSM in PDF form is preferred. Transmit to epederson@cityofmadison.com.

Upon acceptance and recording of the certified survey map by the Dane County Register of Deeds, please transfer the recorded volume, document number, and page numbers to the copies and forward

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a copy to this office for our records. The original survey map with the recording information is permanently kept on file in the Dane County Register of Deeds Office. A copy of the recorded document can be obtained from the Register of Deeds Office, Room 110, City-County Building or the Real Estate Office in the Madison Department of Planning and Development.

Any appeal from this action, including the conditions of approval, must be filed with the Circuit Court within 30 days from the date of this letter. The approval of this CSM shall be null and void if not recorded in two years from the date of the approving resolution or this letter, whichever is later.
