The City of Madison, in cooperation with WISDOT is proposing to reconstruct a portion of Fish Hatchery, Emil Street and Damon Road. The project is scheduled to start in the summer of 2012 and be complete by then end of 2013.

You are being sent this letter to notify you of the public hearing before the Madison Board of Public Works as shown on the attached notice. City Engineering will be making a short presentation at the meeting, followed by the public hearing. Attached to this letter is a schedule of assessments that contains the estimated cost for each property owner on the project.

Portions of the project include federal and county funding. As a result the City of Madison's project costs are lowered, and assessments have been adjusted accordingly. The schedule of assessments attached already includes the applied federal/county discount.

Street Improvements

The proposed street improvement consists of total street reconstruction, including grading, new base course, curb and gutter, asphalt pavement and sidewalk as needed. Driveway aprons will be removed and replaced with concrete aprons matching the new street grades.

The cost of the street improvement will be shared by the City of Madison, Dane County, federal funds and the property owners adjoining the reconstruction. The attached Schedule of Assessments shows a breakdown of costs for each of the street items and the total estimated cost to be assessed to each adjacent property owner. Christy Bachmann is the street designer for this project, and you may contact her at (608) 266-4095 with any questions about how the preliminary assessments were determined.

Storm Sewer

Storm sewer inlets and leads will be installed throughout the project. This work is not assessed to property owners.

Impact on Trees and Landscaping

During construction, it may be necessary to trim tree limbs and/or roots to accommodate the construction. Several trees along Damon Road will be removed to accommodate the realignment of the southern portion of Damon Road.

Assessments - General

A special assessment is a special charge for work that the City is planning to complete. The attached schedule of assessments shows an estimate of the property owners' share of the project based upon the City's assessment policy. When the project is bid, and work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on work actually performed. The final assessment is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with 2.5% interest charged on the unpaid balance.
