Re: Proposed Water Main and Sanitary Sewer Relocation

The City of Madison is proposing to relocate the sanitary sewer and water main between Continental Lane and Independence Lane with the E. Washington Ave. project because there is a retaining wall proposed next to the new sidewalk that will be located in close proximity to both the existing water and sanitary sewer facilities. There are assessments related to the sanitary sewer lateral replacements.

Enclosed with this letter are a Notice of Public Hearing for the proposed sanitary sewer work and a Schedule of Assessments showing the estimated cost to each of the property owners within the construction project limits.

IMPACT ON TREES AND LANDSCAPING

During construction, it may be necessary to trim tree limbs and clear brush in order to accommodate the construction of the new sewer and water lateral(s). Tree conflicts are often encountered with underground utility improvements and City tries to maintain clearances to avoid damage to trees.

PAYMENT OF ASSESSMENTS

The sewer and water assessment is payable in either a lump sum payment or over a period of 8 years with 2.5% interest charged on the unpaid balance.


