Commute Card Notes & Observations

- 1) Over 80 businesses signed up; 64 *active* businesses in September.
- 2) If employees have to transfer on the way to work, the current structure isn't desirable due to \$1.15 transfer; program not cost-effective. (Only works for businesses picking up the cost, as the average will play a role).
- 3) Businesses that signed up in out-lying areas like Fitchburg, Middleton have shown low to no usage per month (transfers an issue).
- 4) Even though businesses can purchase the 31-day unlimited ride pass (\$55) for those employees who have to transfer, implementing two systems, the Commute Card and standard fare purchases isn't as desirable. (Creates more administrative work)
- 5) Initial interest in the program has seemed to peak a bit.
 - a. To increase the number of businesses participating, it may help to take a look at the structure of the program.
 - b. If the Commute Card cost per month for an individual rider did not exceed the current 31-day pass cost of \$55, it would be easier to get more people on board.
 - c. If organizations have members who are currently high frequent riders or those who have to transfer, there's not advantage/incentive to participate.
- 6) Right now from the data, it shows that most current participants in the program are more "moderate" and not HIGH-END riders. Larger businesses are more difficult to get aboard due to equity issues (not all employees having access to Metro) and administrative/payroll issues.
