As you may be aware, the City of Madison is proposing to reconstruct N. Frances Street in 2012. You are being sent this letter to notify you of a public hearing before the Board of Public Works regarding the project, at the above referenced date, time & location. City Engineering will make a short presentation at the meeting, followed by the public hearing. The project will involve special assessments to owners of property adjacent to the project. Attached to this letter is a Schedule of Assessments, which shows estimated costs for each property adjacent to the project.

This letter and corresponding assessments are in addition to the original assessments. Assessments for storm sewer laterals were not included in the original assessments. It became City policy to assess for storm sewer laterals in 2012 and since the project was originally scheduled for 2011, storm assessments were not done.

The scope of the proposed project remains the same and is a complete utility project replacing pavement, storm sewer, sanitary sewer and water main. Curb and gutter, drive aprons and sidewalk will be replaced as necessary.

### **Storm Sewer**

The storm sewer main, leads, and inlets will be replaced as part of this project. Only storm sewer laterals from private property are being assessed. Property owners are assessed the cost to connect private storm sewers that discharge to City property into the City storm sewer. Storm sewer laterals are assessed at 100% cost to property owners. Sidewalk needed for replacement of the storm sewer laterals is also included in this assessment and is assessed at a rate of 50% to property owners.

If you are receiving this letter it means City staff has determined your property has at least one private storm sewer lateral discharging onto City Right of Way. If you have questions about the storm sewer laterals or storm sewer assessments please contact Corey Stelljes of City Engineering at 266-9721 or cstelljes@cityofmadison.com.

### Special Assessments - General

A special assessment is a special charge for work that the City is planning to complete. The attached Schedule of Assessments shows an *estimate* of the property owners' share of the project costs based upon the City's assessment policy. After the project is bid, and work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on bid prices and work actually performed. The final assessment, which will be billed after the completion of the project, is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with 3% interest charged on the unpaid balance.
