The City of Madison is proposing to improve Hanover Street from Randy Lane to Drewry Lane. This project involves special assessments to owners of property along the project. You are being sent this letter to notify you of the public hearing before the Board of Public Works at the above referenced date, time, and location. City Engineering will be making a presentation at the meeting, followed by the public hearing. Attached to this letter is a schedule of assessments that contains the estimated cost for each property on the project.

Scope of Work

This project includes relocation of the to the sanitary sewer main to the road, the installation or replacement of storm sewer, the construction of concrete curb and gutter and an asphalt pavement. Sidewalk will **not** be installed with this project.

Street Improvement Details

The proposed street improvements include the construction of concrete curb and gutter, concrete/Asphalt drive aprons and an asphalt pavement. Hanover Street will be constructed at a width of thirty-two (32) feet, approximately the same width as the existing pavement.

The City and the property owners adjoining the project will share the cost of the street improvements. The property owner is responsible for the cost of the curb and gutter, drive aprons and a cost equal to four (4) feet of the roadway. The attached Schedule of Assessments shows a breakdown of costs for each of the assessable items and the total estimated cost to be assessed to each adjacent property owner.

Drive Aprons

The drive apron, the area between the property line and curb, will be replaced with similar driveway material, unless otherwise requested. For example, if you have an asphalt driveway we will replace the drive apron with asphalt. The aprons are proposed to be the same width as the driveway, at the property line, and will be four feet wider at the curb. Prior to construction, property owners will receive a copy of a Residential Driveway Opening Request form which allows them to change the size of the proposed apron, provided that the driveway complies with the Madison General Ordinances. The signed form authorizes the construction of the larger apron and the resulting larger assessment.

Sanitary Sewer Main and Lateral Replacement for those properties connected to the backyard main:

3913 Hanover Street, 3909 Hanover Street, 3905 Hanover Street, 1610 Randy Lane and 1614 Randy Lane.

The sanitary sewer main and laterals will be installed from the street to the property line with this project to relocate the main from the backyard to the street. The existing main will be abandoned once the propoerties listed above are relocated to the new sanitary sewer in the street right of way. The property owner will have two years to complete relocating their sewer service to the new main located in the street. City will pay for half of the cost to re-plumb basements when the City sewer that is proposed for abandonments is located in a backyard or below a home. Customers will need to submit 3 quotes from plumbers to City Engineering and the City will reimburse customers 50% of the lowest bid amount upon completion of the work. Payment will be made to the customer and not the plumber. Reimbursement costs will be for plumbing work only and not for home remodeling type work. Floor restoration will consist of concrete replacement only. Sanitary sewer laterals are owned by the property owners and it is their responsibility to maintain them.

Sanitary Sewer Main and Lateral Replacement (for all properties)

It is the City of Madison Engineering Division's policy to pay for 75% of the cost to replace sanitary laterals within the public right of way (the length of sewer lateral between the sanitary sewer main and the property line) while the property owner is assessed the remaining 25% of that cost. The estimated property owner's share of the cost for lateral replacement within the public right of way is listed on the schedule of assessments.

Storm Sewer

Storm sewer inlets will be replaced or rebuilt on an as needed basis as part of this project. This work is not assessed to property owners. The costs to connect existing private connections to curb (often downspouts or sump pumps) are assessable. If you are aware of any existing private connections you have to the storm sewer system (either the curb or a structure) or would like a private connection to be provided as part of this project, please contact the storm sewer engineer. If you have any questions or concerns regarding the storm sewer work, please contact Elia E. Acosta, of my staff, at eacosta@cityofmadison.com or 266-4096.

Impact on Trees and Landscaping

Tree pruning in advance of the project is required to reduce the risk of damage to the trees during construction. The City of Madison – Forestry Section will perform the necessary work. For certain species, especially oak and elm trees, the pruning must be completed by April 1st to reduce the chance of disease. If trees need to be removed, City Forestry or City Engineering will notify the adjacent property owner prior to removal.

Tree conflicts are often encountered with sanitary sewer lateral replacements. City Engineering and City Forestry have reviewed the site, and there currently are no additional tree removals planned with the project. During construction, the City will make every effort to work around and protect the trees; however, some tree impacts may not be avoidable. If, during the course of construction, it is determined that any additional trees must be removed, City Engineering will notify property owners adjacent to the tree to be removed, prior to removal.

Please note that construction will also have an impact on existing flower gardens and other plantings within the terrace. With the nature of this work, property owners should anticipate that a the entire terrace will be disturbed. Any plantings or special landscaping features that an owner wishes to save from damage should be removed by the property owner from the terrace area prior to the start of construction. The right-of-way extends to a point approximately fourteen (14) feet from the edge of the existing pavement.

City Forestry Section will evaluate the terrace area for new street trees or replacements when the project is complete. Street trees are typically planted in the spring of the year following the completion of the construction project. Tree species selection is determined by the Forestry Section.

Assessments - General

A special assessment is a special charge for work that the City is planning to complete. The attached schedule of assessments shows an *estimate* of the property owners' share of the project based upon the City's assessment policy. After the project is bid, and work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on bid prices and work actually performed. The final assessment is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with 3.0% interest charged on the unpaid balance.
