Artists and non-profit organizations looking for financial support are invited to two grant writing workshops conducted by the Madison Arts Commission.

The workshops will be on Thursday, Feb. 16 from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. and on Friday, Feb. 17 from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m..

Both will be in Room 260 of the Madison Municipal Building.

Two Madison Arts Commission programs, Project grants and artWORKS! grants, will be examined at the workshops (the BLINK and Signature programs are not part of the workshops).

Project grants provide up to \$3,000 for performances, exhibitions or events, while artWORKS! grants provide up to \$5,000 for neighborhood after school arts-based educational programming.
