


Good Afternoon Jon and Lynn-

I have attached the application materials that are to be submitted to the City of Madison to request additional service locations are added to our liquor license at Edgewood College. I am hoping to attend the ALRC meeting on Wednesday, March 14<sup>th</sup>. All materials must be submitted 2-weeks prior to the meeting.

To clarify our use of the liquor license I wanted to explain that our license is used for catered events on campus only. I am the *director of dining services* and the liquor agent for the college. I have been with Edgewood College for 5 years and in that time have overseen dozens of events that involved alcohol, none of which has ever been a problem. The majority of our events are catered to adult groups both from within the college and outside invited guests. On the rare occasion that students are present at an event involving alcohol my staff in present and cards all students. Again, we have had no incidents in the past five years that I have been with the college. Three of the four additional locations will be in the new Visual and Theatre Arts Center.
