## Resolution of the Board of the Regent Neighborhood Association Regarding

The University of Wisconsin Student Athletic Performance Center

Whereas, the University of Wisconsin Athletic Department plans to add an addition to the north end of the stadium known as the Student Athletic Performance Center, to construct a linking building between the stadium and the McClain Center building, to refurbish part of the stadium and the McClain Center, to create a new green space where the Lot 17 surface parking is currently, and to make certain other changes in the area along Badger Way; and

Whereas, negotiations have taken place between the University and RNA's UW Relations Committee to mitigate potential impacts of the construction and operation of the new facility on the Regent Neighborhood,

Therefore, be it resolved that the Board of the Regent Neighborhood Association hereby endorses the project with the following conditions that have been agreed to by the parties in the negotiations:

- All construction vehicles will enter the site from Engineering Drive. No construction vehicles will be allowed on Breese Terrace, except for the few days needed to construct the retaining wall at the south end of the north practice field.
- Construction on weekends starting no earlier than 9:00 AM and lasting no later than 5:30
- No additional noise will be generated, and no additional light will be directed toward the neighborhood after completion of the project.
- Amplified sound on the north practice field and in the new multi-purpose open space between the Lot 17 ramp and Engineering Hall will meet the existing City of Madison noise ordinance. Any violation of the noise ordinance will be remediated by the University.
