**WHEREAS**, on March 14, 2012, the Transit and Parking Commission held a public hearing regarding proposed Parking Utility rate changes; and

**WHEREAS,** the Transit and Parking Commission, upon consideration of information obtained as a result of the public hearing, approved Parking Rate changes on April 11, 2012, as shown on the attached Parking Rate Schedule; and

WHEREAS, the Transit and Parking Commission considered and amended Ordinance ID #25912 on April 11, 2011, related to changes to on-street parking rates and meter hoods, and recommended adoption of the substitute ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 1, 2012, the Common Council approved Substitute Ordinance ID #25912 (Enactment #ORD-12-00066) and the associated rate changes; and

**WHEREAS,** said rates for on-street parking meter rates and hoods, and Parking Rate changes will take effect on June 1, 2012;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the attached Madison Parking Utility Parking Rate Schedule effective June 1, 2012, reflects the official rate schedule of the Madison Parking Utility as previously adopted by the Transit and Parking Commission and the Common Council.

### **Notes**

- (a) Cashiered parking rates calculated in half-hour increments; there is a 20 minute grace period
  - The Evening/Weekend Maximum rate applies to cashiered parking during the following time periods:
  - Hours parked after 6 p.m. weeknights (until 5 a.m. the following day); and
  - Hours parked on Saturdays/Sundays (from 5 a.m. until 5:00 a.m. the following day).

Parking garages can be used free of charge between 9 p.m. and 7 a.m. on days when a snow emergency has been declared.

Coupons: Businesses and individuals can request coupons for distribution to customers/clients.

- The Parking Utility invoices for the value of redeemed coupons plus a 10% administrative fee.
- (b) All garages and surface lots are enforced 24/7.
- (c) Competitive Event Pricing -- UW/Kohl Center/Camp Randall Special Event pricing is \$10 to \$25; Alliant Center Special Event pricing is \$6 (5800 stalls).
- (d) On-street meters are enforced in general from 8 am to 6 pm , however, some high demand commercial night-time venues such as Langdon Street by Memorial Union are to be enforced from 8 am to 7 pm. UW meters in this area are enforced 7am-10pm.
- (e) Multi-space meters will continue to be phased-in during 2012 at \$1.75/hour on-street. On-street single pole and multi space meters to have the same hourly rate.
- (f) Eligible carpoolers and electric car drivers qualify for the (discounted) Monthly Resident rate and are entitled to immediate occupancy in select ramps.
- (g) Parkers and the Utility are required to provide 30-days notice to terminate monthly parking agreements.
- (h) Regular Monthly Limited Hours, Monday Friday Premium Pass - 24/7 access, even during events R = Resident NR - B = Non-Resident/Business
