I reviewed the application and do not believe the concept described can be legally accomplished. The liquor licensed establishments cannot allow patrons to leave there primary premises or their legal street café's with alcohol as is described in the plan. The Class B License would need to be by a non-profit organization that would then dispense the beer in the event zone on the street. The alcohol drinkers from the event could not comingle on the premises or the café of a licensed establishment in the block.

I also had a conversation with the applicant, Brian Haltinner and explained what I believed to be the issues with the application. He brought up the Isthmus event several years ago in the same block. I explained that this concept had also been raised last year as the committee reviewed application for the Majestic and Woof's planned events. I explained the outcome of the ALRC meeting which is describe in the preceding paragraph.

The Central District does not support this application on the grounds that the plan as described is not legal.
