General Information:

The Applicant is requesting a Certificate of Appropriateness to install a new entrance door system in an existing garage door opening. The property is zoned C2.

Landmarks Ordinance sections:

33.19(11)(g) <u>Guideline Criteria for Exterior Alteration in the Third Lake Ridge Historic District - Parcels Zoned for Commercial Use</u>.

- 1. Alterations of the height of any existing structure shall be visually compatible with the buildings and environment within its visually related area.
- 2. Alterations of the street facade(s) of any existing structure shall retain the original or existing historical rhythm of solids and voids.
- Alterations of the street facade(s) of any existing structure shall retain the original or existing historical materials.
- 4. Alterations of the roof of any existing structure shall retain its existing historical appearance.

Staff Comments:

Staff believes that the standards for granting a Certificate of Appropriateness for the exterior alteration are met and recommends approval by the Landmarks Commission.
