This summer, the City of Madison Traffic Engineering Division and the MUFN (Metropolitan Unified Fiber Network) project, via Intercon Construction, will be installing conduit on the South side of Atwood Ave from Maple Ave to Walter St and 1100' on South side of E. Broadway from E. Broadway Service Dr to Stoughton Rd.

This conduit will be used primarily for fiber optic cables to enhance the City's communication capabilities. There will be a public hearing to discuss the project before the City of Madison Board of Public Works on Wednesday, July 11, 2012, at 5:30 p.m. in Room 108 of the City-County Building, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd.

The conduit will primarily be installed by directional boring to reduce the excavation areas. Traffic will not be significantly affected by this work, but there could be some off-peak hour lane closures.
