## **PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

## CITY OF MADISON PRELIMINARY RECOMMENDATIONS OF 2013-2014 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT OBJECTIVES AND PROJECTED USE OF CDBG, CITY, ESG, HOME AND RELATED FUNDS AS PART OF THE 2013-2014 ACTION PLANS

The CDBG Committee invites Madison citizens to attend a public hearing on preliminary recommendations for Community Development funds for the years 2013-2014 and the 2013 Action Plan. The hearing is scheduled to begin at 5:30 PM on Thursday, August 2, 2012, in room 260 at the Madison Municipal Building, located at 215 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. Madison, Wl. Citizens may also send their comments in writing to the Community Development Block Grant Office, P.O. Box 2627, Madison, WI 53701-2627, via e-mail at <a href="mailto:cddapplications@cityofmadison.com">cddapplications@cityofmadison.com</a>, or through the CDBG website at <a href="mailto:www.cityofmadison.com/cdbg">www.cityofmadison.com/cdbg</a>. Comments received prior to the public hearing will be reviewed by the Committee and considered in their discussion.

The Committee will revise these preliminary recommendations based upon those comments and additional information and make its final recommendations to the Mayor for incorporation into the budget. Once approved by the Common Council, the City of Madison will submit this statement, along with separate recommendations for ESG funds, to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the funding period, in conformance with the requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1973, as amended.

This statement allocates \$1,196,855 in anticipated year 2013 and 2014 CDBG Entitlement funds, \$799,184 in anticipated HOME funds, \$126,743 in anticipated ESG funds, and \$1,312,077 in City funds to support activities to further these goals:

- improve Madison's housing;
- develop Madison's economy;
- · strengthen Madison's neighborhoods;
- revitalize selected concentration neighborhoods;
- broaden citizen access and choice;
- expand employment and training opportunities; and
- plan and administer the programs effectively.

One hundred percent of the listed projects are federally funded unless noted otherwise. A list of funded activities follows. These projects will start January 1, 2013, and most activities will be completed by December 31, 2014.

The City may amend this Final Consolidated Statement when the City determines that the proposed revisions constitute a substantial change in the purpose, scope, or funding of an activity. Hence, the City will require CDBG Committee review and public notice of any new projects which are not included in this statement, or which involve a different population, purpose, scope, primary location, or set of beneficiaries from that previously described in such notices. The City will publish a notice of the Committee meeting scheduled to discuss the revisions, and hold a public hearing on those proposed revisions prior to final approval and the submission of a Revised Statement to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

The City and project administrators have designed these activities to principally benefit, over the two-year period 2013-2014, persons of low and moderate income, which is the primary customer/group of these HUD programs.
