The above-referenced establishment holds a Class B Combination liquor license issued by the City of Madison. The food and alcohol percentages on Chasers' liquor license requires the establishment to meet the definition of a restaurant as defined in Madison General Ordinances (MGO) Sec. 38.02.¹ There has been some concern on the part of the Madison Police Department that Chasers no longer meets the definition of a restaurant and is operating primarily as a bar and not a restaurant.

On behalf of Captains Carl Gloede of the Madison Police Department Central District, I am requesting an audit of Chasers for purposes of determining whether the establishment meets the definition of a restaurant as defined in MGO Sec. 38.02.

^{1 &}quot;Restaurant" has the meaning as defined in Wis. Stats. Sec. 254.61(5) and whose sale of alcohol beverages accounts for 50% or less of the establishment's gross receipts."
