

Banfield Charitable Trust, requesting the use of Warner Park on April 20, 2013 for Bark for Your Heart, a 5k walk/run for people and dogs.

Parks Staff recommends approval, with the following conditions:

1. Aldermanic notification. (Alder. Satya Rhodes-Conway, [district12@cityofmadison.com](mailto:district12@cityofmadison.com).)
2. Dogs participating in this event will be allowed only on the paths and roadways of Warner Park, and must be on a six foot leash at all times. Dog waste must be cleaned up and placed in proper receptacles.
3. Banfield will make sure that all dogs are up to date on vaccinations before allowing them to register. After the event, Banfield will determine the number of dogs that participated, and will pay for a daily dog permit (\$5 per dog in 2012) for each dog that did not already have an annual dog park permit.
4. Sponsor understands that no permanent marking of streets, paths, or sidewalks will be allowed – chalk may be used, but not spray paint or spray chalk.
5. Sponsor will arrange a site plan meeting, at least two weeks in advance, with the East Parks Supervisor, (Craig Klinke, [cklinke@cityofmadison.com](mailto:cklinke@cityofmadison.com)) and agrees to any and all site recommendations he will make.
6. The Walk/Run route will not block the Sherman or Northport Avenue entrances to the park.
7. Fees will be paid at least one week prior to the event.
8. Sponsor will post a \$3,000 damage deposit with the Parks Division prior to the event and acknowledges that this organization will be responsible for any and all actual field renovation costs which may result from this event.
9. Sponsor will provide a certificate of insurance covering this event and naming the City of Madison as “additional insured.”
10. Sponsor understands that no driving or parking on the grass is allowed.
11. Sponsor will be responsible for full clean-up of the park area after the event.
12. Amplification will be allowed from 9am to 1pm, but sound will be kept to a reasonable level.
13. If anything will be sold in the park, Banfield will complete a vending permit application. If any tents larger than 10’ X 10’ will be erected, Banfield will complete a temporary structure permit application and will call Digger’s Hotline at least three working days before the tent will be placed.

Estimated fees (based on 2012 prices):

Warner Shelter: \$130  
Scheduling Fee: \$120  
PA Permit: \$100  
Daily Dog Park Permits: \$5 per dog

plus additional fees if there are tents other than pop-ups, and/or vending.
