Amending Section 12.915(8) of the Madison General Ordinances to prohibit taxicabs waiting for passengers on State Street.

DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: This ordinance repeals language allowing taxicabs to enter State Street and wait in designated loading areas. Cab stands and other waiting areas are being designated on streets off State Street.

The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

Subdivision (a) of Subsection (8) entitled "Public Passenger Vehicle Regulations" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

"(a) Taxicabs and other public passenger vehicles shall enter the area for the sole purpose of receiving or discharging passengers specifically requesting service to properties directly adjacent to State Street. ~~Between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. during Central Standard Time, and between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. during Daylight Savings Time, these vehicles may drive onto State Street to wait in designated loading zones for prospective fares and during the hours specified these vehicles are subject to the limitation regarding idling as provided in subsection (7)(e).~~"
